

# Application for Audition for the Foundation Youth Band

Auditions will be accepted between September and December of each year for pipers and drummers who will be 20 years of age or younger within the next 2 year period. Auditions will be kept on file until a position becomes available. Applicants may be called up to audition in person.

The Audition will consist of a MSR, Jig and Hornpipe and selection of own choice music. Auditions can be submitted via video tape or DVD.

The Foundation Youth Band will consist of pipers and drummers representing each of our Centres.

Audition tapes must be accompanied by an application form obtainable from the RNZPBA website,.
